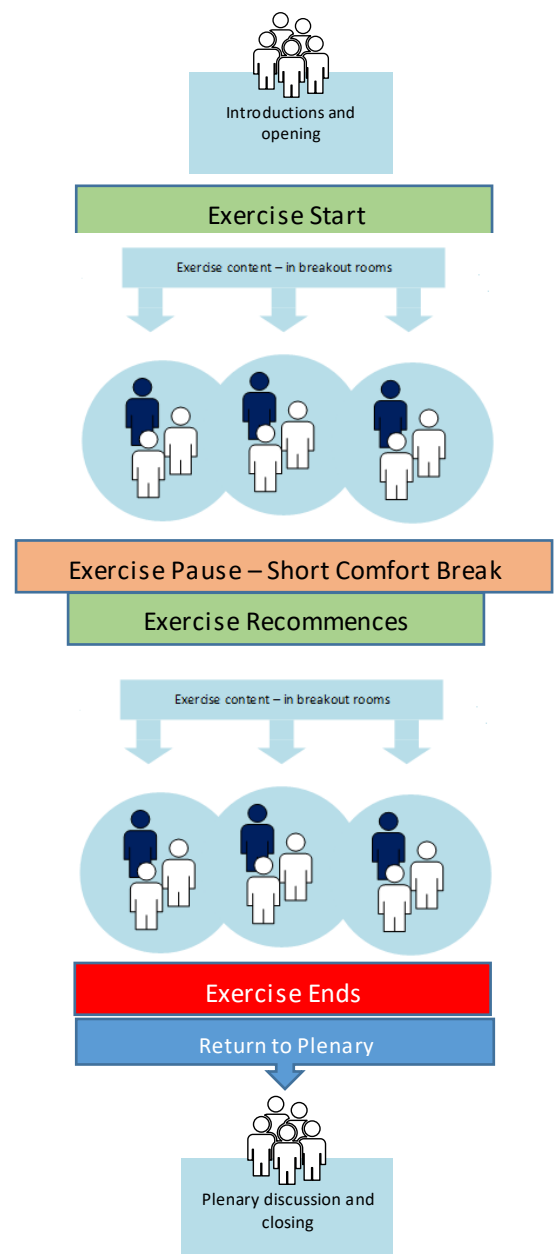

Frequently Asked Questions



Why have I been invited to participate in the guided exercise event?

A. You have been invited as your organisation has previously registered for the NI CyberBase Programme. Your name was submitted as part of the registration details and your organisation has a Cyber Incident Plan in place.

Q. How many people from my organisation can you cater for?

A. Ideally we would advise a minimum of 3 and maximum of 8 and to make the exercise effective.

Q. Who should attend from my organisation?

A. To exercise your plan effectively we recommend that your Cyber Incident Response Team (CIRT) attend.

Essential participants

- Senior decision maker – someone who can make important decisions for your business.
- Senior IT stakeholder/decision maker – someone who has overall responsibility for your IT landscape.
- Technical IT security advisers – Staff members who can provide advice on how your IT infrastructures operate technically.

Desirable participants

- Media/press/communications/BCP representative – someone who would manage your internal/external communications during an incident if needed.
- Company policy & legal advisers – someone who has oversight of your company policies, such as HR, business continuity, etc.

Q. When are these events?

A. A number of events have been timetabled in March and April 2021.

Q. Can I select any date?

A. Of the dates listed, you will be asked to select two dates (in order of preference) that you and your team are available. You may not be allocated your first preference as number of organisations listed for each event is limited to five. You will be advised of your allocated date and any joining instructions as soon as exercise registration has closed.

- Q. What if I cannot attend on the date allocated to my organisation?**
- A.** It will be up to your organisation to send a deputy or if all of your delegates are unable to attend, please contact NICyberbase Project Team (NICyberbase@finance-ni.gov.uk) as soon as possible.
- Q. How much time will I have to give to this event?**
- A.** The Exercise Event day will last approximately three hours. We would ask that you set time aside prior to the event to check IT connections.
- Q. Do I have to do any preparation in advance of the event?**
- A.** There is no pre-read material however knowledge of your own CIRP will be advantageous.
- Q. Will there be any opportunity to ask questions at the event?**
- A.** Yes. Time has been included.
