DoJ has a statutory responsibility to bring forward new legislation to improve the operation of the NI Police Pension scheme for its members. From 1 April 2024, the Police Pension Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015 (2015 scheme) were amended to minimise the potential of legal challenge by the removal of restrictions surrounding eligibility for ill health retirement; all members having paid a reduced contribution rate up to that point, now pay a full member contribution rate from that date.

These regulations will now provide those members of the 2015 scheme (previously excluded from applying for ill health retirement until 1 April 2024) with the option to buy back their 2.5% employee contribution shortfall, for the period from which they joined the 2015 scheme until 31 March 2024 and by doing so further minimise the potential of legal challenge.

The option will apply irrespective of geographic base.
